#### INTRODUCTION TO APPLICATION FORM

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE COMPLETING FORM

RBS is a 5½-week-long Christian discipleship school for youth who have just completed their Form 5 or Form 6, or are on break from college or university. It is run by the Brethren Assemblies of Malaysia as a ministry of Inter Brethren Assemblies (IBA) Youth Development with a three-fold goal of:

- INSPIRING you to a heartfelt and committed devotion to God;
- **INSTRUCTING** you in his Word in the fundamentals of your faith, so that you might grow to become a mature, thinking Christian rather than a spoon-fed one;
- **INVOLVING** you in practical service for God through the missions trips.

RBS is run in the format of a <u>school rather than a camp</u>. It is designed to be a memorable once-in-a-lifetime experience, where the focus is on the <u>learning</u>, <u>discovery and practice of basic spiritual disciplines</u>. As such, applicants <u>must meet the minimum prerequisites</u>, which are:

- a born-again believer;
- recommended by the leaders of his/her local church;
- willing to study hard and complete all assignments, participate in all RBS activities, and abide by the RBS rules as directed by the Principal.

The classroom component of RBS will be conducted at the Highlands Christian Centre in Cameron Highlands. The practical missions component requires participants to travel in groups to various locations around Peninsular Malaysia, where their ministry base will be the local Brethren churches. The debriefing and Graduation Night will be held in Petaling Jaya. **Students must attend the entire duration of the school** (exception provided **only** for family emergencies).

A good standard of behaviour and adherence to the rules will be expected from you. On dressing and the clothes you decide to bring with you, we encourage you to cover too much rather than too little. RBS students come from different backgrounds, cultures and church experiences. We need to be sensitive to not offending or distracting other students by the way we dress. This is an important principle not just for the school, but also in our approach to life and godliness.

Note also that though you may bring a handphone with you so that you can use it while you travel, you will be required to surrender it to the staff for the entire duration of the school. A communal phone for the use of students will be made available during selected periods in the day during the course of the school.

The fee for attending RBS is as follows:

- For applicants from IBA-affiliated churches: RM1400 (you are required to pay RM700; your church will pay RM700)
- For applicants from non IBA-affiliated churches: RM1700

If you are unsure if your church is an IBA-affiliated church, please contact May Lee Hilmy at 016-240-6444.

The fee covers all materials, food and accommodation during the length of RBS, personal accident insurance, and transport to and from your mission trips.

The fee does <u>not</u> cover your transportation to and from RBS and other expenses you may incur during RBS (e.g. laundry, own snacks, book purchases, etc). Please take note that all students are required to purchase one book (approximately RM40) for a book report during RBS.

The difference in the fees above reflects the subsidy given by IBA to students from affiliated churches, as IBA is primarily funded by contributions from those churches. Applicants from non-affiliated churches pay a fee that is closer to the actual cost incurred by that student for the duration of the school. If you encounter financial difficulty in meeting the RBS attendance fee for whatever reason, please contact us for assistance.

Parents of IBA-affiliated applicants who are financially able to bear the full cost of the fees for RBS 2019 are strongly encouraged to consider reimbursing the church portion of the fees (RM700) directly to the church itself. We encourage this in order to ease the financial burden of the sending church.

Please take note that the attached application form is in two parts. Part A is to be filled out by the student applicant and Part B is to be filled out by your church youth worker or elder/deacon. You need to complete Part A and send it together with a cheque as the full payment for your portion of the RBS fee (RM700 for applicants from IBA-affiliated churches; RM1700 for applicants from non IBA-affiliated churches) to the address listed below. Part B is to be sent separately by your church youth worker or elder/deacon, to the same address. Both Parts A and B of your application form must be fully completed and received latest by 11 November 2018. Incomplete forms will be rejected.

As such, it is to your advantage to ensure your church youth worker or elder/deacon sends in their portion of the form (Part B) as soon as possible. Please be warned that a maximum of 52 places are available for RBS, and places fill up very quickly each year. All fully-completed applications (Part A + RBS fee + Part B) will be treated on a first-come-first-served basis. Standby places will be allocated on the same basis in the event of dropouts from those initially accepted.

- All applications must be accompanied with payment for the RBS fee, payable by (1) Direct bank transfer to Maybank Account 5140 5761 4292 (Please email transfer notification to office@ibayd.org) OR (2) by cheque in favour of "Residential Bible School" and write your name and church clearly on the back of the cheque. This amount is RM700 for IBA-affiliated churches and RM1700 for non-IBA affiliated churches.
- All applications (including the RBS fee) must be received by 11 November 2018.
- Incomplete applications may be rejected.
- Application does not mean acceptance.
- Preference will be given to youth from Brethren (IBA-affiliated) churches in Malaysia. <u>Applicants from non-Brethren churches may apply but will only be accepted on a standby basis</u>. If there are places available immediately after the closing date after all IBA-affiliated applicants have been considered, the remaining places will be granted to non-Brethren applicants on a first-come-first-served basis.
- We will contact you directly immediately after receiving your application to confirm receipt. If you do not receive a call from us one or two days after the expected time of arrival of your application, please contact May Lee Hilmy immediately to notify us.
